A Soft Start to the Year

The return to sales after the three week recess over Christmas saw almost 51,000 offered, with the positive sentiment from last year continuing. Alas it was to last only on the opening day, with a soft finish for most of the merino indicators by the end of the week. Merino skirtings did hold onto their early gains to close stronger, as did the eastern cardings. Crossbreds were unchanged to very modest losses over their micron range.

Over the recess trading was reasonably subdued until after the New Year, where good inquiry had led to some good business being written. Once sales resumed, it was the indent orders that were very quiet, and exporters were able to take advantage of the subdued competition in the last two selling days. No doubt that the announcement of next weeks 56,000 bale offering had perhaps motivated the indent buyers to hold back this week to see where the market may find itself later next week. The Australian dollar had also held around 68 US cents until late last week, influencing purchasing power of earlier written sales.

This year we have undertaken to help raise funds for Macquarie Home Stay. This is an accommodation facility in Dubbo for patients and family members receiving medical care.

The second stage expansion is underway and Macwool along with Endeavour Wool Exports have pledged to raise \$65,000 by the end of this year to fund the completion and fitout of a two-bedroom unit. It is a fantastic facility that the surrounding districts of Dubbo have needed for years.

We are calling on growers to donate wool, either oddments or a bale or two lower lines to be auctioned at one of our three special wool sales during the year. Your bale of oddments that might be worth \$400-\$500 could double that at the charity auction for such a cause, which is where Endeavour Wool Exports contribution will come from.
